Student Progress Tracking

A student website has been established to provide information and an easy link to the students' websites.

The student website address on the Internet is: **student-sites.net**. The home page provides:

1. The basic course syllabus. The syllabus specific to the course can be reached from the online home page.
2. The competencies, or goals, for lessons and exercises.
3. Links to W³C's websites for reference to web standards and tutorials.
4. A link to xhtml and CSS examples.
5. A dropdown list from which to select your class home page.

Your Can Follow Your Progress:

1. Provides a link to view the competencies you have earned and are working towards.
2. The page with your competencies has a link to the ***class competencies chart***.
3. A happy face is placed in the squares representing competencies to denote the attainment of that competency. By placing your cursor in an individual competency square and clicking on your left mouse button, an alert box appears to present the competency represented by the square.

Assigned Hosted Websites:

1. When you have completed the Basic Xhtml competencies, you will be assigned your own hosted website. The student home page provides a quick link to observe your website – just click on your name.
2. It also provides a link to view the competencies you have earned.
3. The page with your competencies has a link to the class competencies chart. Clicking in the individual squares produces a small alert box that presents the competency the square represents.
